Another series of our successful regional workshops **“Accelerating Agroecology Transition: Your potential role and benefits of contributing to a European network of Living Labs and Research Infrastructures”** took place in Seville (Spain), Budapest (Hungary) and Frankfurt (Germany) in May and June. Participants from all over Europe, representing a wide range of LLs and RIs were invited in a hybrid format to exchange and discuss about the future network of Agroecology Living Labs and Research Infrastructures and related topics and issues.

During the workshop, participants developed recommendations to be considered in the implementation of the future network. The exchange focused on the importance of removing barriers to equal opportunities for participation and representation regarding partners, audiences and regional contexts as well as the potential role of the network in promoting a policy dialogue.
