

Update on policy process at European level: Partnership on Agroecology Living Labs and Research Infrastructures

The partnership on Agroecology Living Labs and Research Infrastructures, abbreviated AELLRI, has released the draft Strategic Research and Innovation Agenda (SRIA). This was the object of a broad consultation. Responses to the consultation will be consolidated and the SRIA core group will update the draft SRIA. The consortium that will respond to the call for the partnership is under construction. The call is expected to open in December and close in April. ALL-Ready, as a key advisor to the SCAR Agroecology Strategic Working Group, has contributed to the partnership SRIA.

So far, 2022 was a busy year and ALL-Ready participated in and organised several events. Below you find some highlights.



First ALL-Ready project meeting held in Paris

The first annual in person ALL-Ready consortium meeting hosted by INRAE was held on the 8-9 March 2022 in Paris in a hybrid format. The objectives of the meeting were to take stock of the achievements and main outcomes delivered so far, to foster the interconnection between the work packages and contextualise the activities of ALL-Ready within the future European partnership on agroecology living labs and research infrastructures.



Pilot network meeting in Ghent

The second pilot network meeting was successfully held 4-5 July 2022 in Ghent. The meeting involved the pilot network members and relevant stakeholders, who had the opportunity to get familiar with the activities of each living lab and research infrastructure. The Workshop ended with a magnificent living lab demonstration at ILVO's agroecological testing platform in Hansbeke.



ALL-Ready at Biofach

To discuss how organic and agroecology can positively influence each other, ALL-Ready organised a session at this year's Biofach summer edition. The four Biofach summer edition. The four invited speakers agreed that agroecology functions like an umbrella including organic agriculture, the latter being usually a forerunner when it comes to agroecology practices. They emphasized that organic and agroecology share more similarities than differences, working in synergy.
